


enough of what a privilege it was to serve as your Commodore for the past two years and can't wait to see all of us together on the water again.




# 2020/2021 Season Southwest Florida Inter-Club Cruising and Day Sailing Programs

The fall cruising schedule has been included below. The goal is to continue the popular events but also to try a couple of longer cruises. For example, a trip to the Keys has been added in March and a



Looking forward to cruising with you in the fall as Jenn and I hope to travel north in early June.


