


ways to increase the value of your club to its members and welcome your input. Let us know what you think would improve your experiences!

# 2020/2021 Season Southwest Florida Inter-Club GCSC Fleet Captain Cruising – Rick Reed

Jenn and I are back in Florida. Fall has arrived in Massachusetts and *Makana* is resting, ready for the winter. Unfortunately, SAMI had to cancel their Sept 12th Anchoring Event at Smokehouse Bay. No, not a Covid 19 issue but as all of you who are in Florida are aware, hurricane Sally dumped several inches of rain on Marco that weekend.

GCSC has had a great season with their Tequila pursuit races with up to a dozen boats participating and fun sailing events at Sugden. These are obviously tough times to hold cruising events but Florida offers more opportunity than many other destinations. For example, the Bahamas are still struggling. The September issue of "Southernmost Boating Magazine" reported that you can sail to the Bahamas (not Grand Bahama Island) if you have a test 48 hours before arriving but there is considerable paperwork and "fines for not wearing masks are \$200, a period of one-month imprisonment, or both".

Six boats have already made reservations at the Marlin Marina for the **March 12-15 Marathon Key Cruise.** Others are planning to anchor or grab a mooring.








# Tequila Racing Party – Sunday, October 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020 10 am – at the NSYC


It's been a great season. Thanks to all the participants!

# WHAT DOES A TEQUILA SUNRISE MEAN TO YOU????

- 1. For Dennis & Jennifer Auray on their Beneteau 373 "NO NAME", it means rising early, very early! Dennis volunteered to set the marks for the course to be sailed, allowing all participants to enjoy SUMMER SAILING in SW FL!
  "NO NAME" departs the dock at dusk setting sail out to the GULF of MEXICO on a journey to strategically place inflated buoys identifying the course to be sailed today. Following the bi-weekly events "NO NAME" returns to those strategic locations to employ their MOB (MAN OVER-BOARD), skills while retrieving these inflated buoys for deflating, cleaning, and repacking for the following event.
- 2. For GCSC Frank Brown, director of regattas, the TEQUILA SUNRISE means having the ship in shape to depart the dock at SUNRISE for the sequential start of these events. Each participant has an assigned handicapped start time based on the West Florida Performance Handicap Rating System unique sailing value. Frank Brown advises all participants who have ever indicated an interest in these events: A. What the course to be sailed will be for the day. B. What their individual start time will be. C. Where the start will take place. D. What the route of the event will be for the event. E. What the

- total distance of the various legs of that course will add up to. F. The VFH Channel to be monitored for all announcements regarding the event will be broadcast on.
- 3. For Patrick Evans it means a perception that has led to events offering an early morning TEQUILA SUNRISE to sailors from Marco Island to Cape Coral. As many as 16 boats participate in these bi-weekly events.
- 4.
